### **Code of Conduct - Parents**

The following is based on the Sports Council's Code for Parents which the squad fully endorses.

- Remember that the swimmers are involved in the sport for their enjoyment and achievement not yours.
- Be realistic about your Child's abilities, do not over expect. Harm can be done when children consistently fall short of their parent's expectations.
- Teach your child that honest effort is as important as victory so the results of each race is accepted without undue disappointment. A personal best can be as big an achievement as a gold medal.
- Remember that children learn best from example. Applaud good performance by other swimmers in the squad and those from other clubs.
- Do not publicly question the official's judgement and never their honesty. Encourage your children to show the same courtesy.
- Be helpful to your child but do not coach him or her. The coaches are there to do the coaching and have been doing so for many years. If you think there is a problem speak to the coach first.
